Songs For the Slow Lane

Last summer I was lucky. I heard the corncrake and the cuckoo, two voices less and less common in Ireland. On Tory island the corncrake's creek—creek, though not melodious, was especially welcome as a sound I hadn't heard for years. The islanders have done well in offering a safe haven, a sanctuary, to this ground-nesting bird who was once a full citizen of our hay fields.

Just as the Creator finds a different expression in every living being, so a light of God's presence goes out when a species becomes extinct. If all the birdsong stopped, we would be lonely, not only for blackbird and robin as for old neighbours, but deeply lonely in spirit.

The Christian tradition of facing east when we pray and celebrate Eucharist is sadly no longer observed. Sadly, because for Christians to face east is also to face our rising sun, Jesus, the light of the world. It is the way a pilgrim prays, going out to meet and greet Christ. When we face east we recognise that the cosmos is praying with us. As Pope Benedict says; 'the cosmos is speaking of Christ'.

In other words, the corncrake and the cuckoo are speaking of Christ in their acclamation of creation. We are misled when we think it is a good idea to withdraw from creation in order to praise God. Rather, it is comforting to know that we are not alone when we pray. The birds have well finished their morning prayer by the time we get up to face the rising sun!

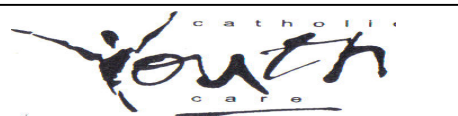
REMINDER
