Thought for the Week

"Their eyes were opened and they recognised Him" - Luke Chapter 24

A God of Compassion

A boy who was misbehaving in class was sent by his teacher to the headmaster. Having listened intently to the lad's version of events, the headmaster took out a blank book, wrote down the lad's name in it, observing as he did so "You have not been sent to me before this. Now I don't know who you are, possibly you are a good lad for I know even good lads with great possibilities sometimes make mistakes".

Now I'll just make a note in pencil that you were sent to me today and I'll also give the reason why you were sent. Note carefully, I'm writing in pencil and am not leaning heavily on it as I write. If you are not sent to me again this year I will erase this entry from my book and nobody will ever know about it. At these words the boy's eyes brightened up and lost their look of apprehension—his face broke in to a broad smile. They parted as friends without resentment or acrimony and especially with hope for the future.

At the beginning of Mass we ask God who is full of compassion and rich in mercy to pardon our wayward steps. St. Paul refers to the Risen Saviour as pleading for us with his Heavenly Father and showing His sacred wounds. 'Compassion' Jean Vannier says is a word of great beauty: it means suffering with, putting ourselves in the other person's place and acting accordingly. God is a God of compassion, able to empathise with us in our sufferings having been through the dark valley of suffering Himself.

Compassion is full of meaning. It means sharing the same pain. Sharing the same suffering. Sharing the same agony and loneliness.

Accepting in to my heart the misery in yours your pain calls out to me: it touches my heart: it awakens a response and I become one with you in your pain. I may not be able to remove your pain but by trying to understand it and share it I make it possible to bear it in a way that enhances your dignity and allows you to grow.

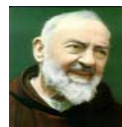
