Going on up to the Spirit in the Sky

"When I die and they lay to rest. Gonna go to the place that's best. When they lay me down to die. Goin' up to the Spirit in the sky". Do you remember this song? I think it's from the 1970's and was covered by another band in the early 1980's. As a child I loved this song because it talked about having a "friend called Jesus" and going up to heaven. Today we celebrate the feast of the Ascension, it is a day to think about heaven. But it's not easy to talk about heaven because none of us have been there. Our friend Jesus is the only one who came down from heaven to tell us what it is like. The gospel tells us about Jesus' place in heaven: 'The Lord Jesus was taken up to heaven: there at the right hand of God he took his place.' The gospel also tells us: 'There are many rooms in my Father's house...I am going to prepare a place for you. [Jn :24: 2-3]

What we celebrate in Christ's Ascension is something that involves us too. The basis of our hope for heaven is summed up in today's Preface: 'Christ is the beginning, the head of the Church, where he has gone, we hope to follow'. Just as Jesus returned to His Father, our hope is that we who follow Christ on earth will also follow him to heaven to live with him forever in the glory and love of God. This is our faith, this is our joy; that no matter what life throws at us we can carry on with joyful hearts, because as the song says, 'When I die and they lay me to rest. Gonna go to the place that's best. When they lay me down to die. Goin' up to the Spirit in the sky.' Fr. Michael.
