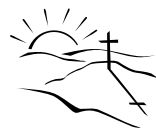

## Christ is Risen, Alleluia

Today we celebrate the great day of Easter. Easter Sunday is not just one feast among others, but the "Feast of feasts" the greatest day in the Church's year, greater than all other feast days even Christmas! Faith in the resurrection of Jesus is a fundamental part of our Christian faith. If Christ did not rise from the dead then our faith is in vain, but Christ has risen from the dead, alleluia!

As you celebrate this wonderful day in our life of faith try to imagine just how amazed and excited the two women must have been when Jesus met them.
