Thought for the Week

"When we serve the poor, we serve Jesus Christ" St. Rose of Lima

Lent: Season of Hope.

The old man was reading his prayer book in a bus shelter while waiting for the rain to stop. Noticing a stranger looking at him he smiled and said. 'The Father is very fond of me.' and with this deep assurance of his faith he continued praying.

How good it would be if we could face into Lent with the same strong conviction that 'the father is very fond of me.' To know that He knows me inside out and loves me deeply, that he wants me to be happy. Lent is a call to this conversion, a call to put God at the centre of my life.

We are made for God and our vision is not limited to what is purely human. We are strengthened by prayer, fasting and by giving to the poor. These traditional practices, prayer, fasting and almsgiving, are ways of expressing our need of forgiveness, our hope of compassion. 'Turn our hearts back to you, we pray in the liturgy,' that we may profit by our Lenten observance.

Self denial can be such a new venture for us, or so difficult, that we become so engrossed in what we re doing for the Lord, secretly and unconsciously patting ourselves on the back. We may not be as blatant as the Pharisees in the parable who boasted to God of his virtue Lk.18;122, but can you honestly say you never felt a subtle, secret smugness in your ability to fast, in your 'generosity' to the poor, in your effort to pray?

In an age when achievement and self determination are rated so highly it really is hard to be humble. So it is worthless and may be harmful to our soul, if we only deny ourselves and do not at the same time follow Jesus. This is what He asks us: 'if you want to be a follower of mine, renounce yourself and take up your cross and follow me Lk: 9:23

If your Lent is looking at Jesus you cannot but be changed. This conversion may not be sudden or dramatic, as it was with St. Paul. It may be quiet, a slow melting of the heart. Your judgements and condemnations of others begin to fall away. No longer do you insist on your 'rights', no longer do you grumble when you are overlooked and forgotten. And that pain or that cross that was unbearable before, you now carry with new courage and hope.

How good it would be if we could face into Lent with conviction and like the old man say with great assurance the father is very fond of me and continue to pray. Sr. Margaret.
