The Beatification of John Paul II

This weekend millions will gather in Rome for the Beatification of John Paul II which takes place this Sunday in St. Peter's Square. The occasion will recall memories of a man who was a huge influence for good in the world. It is believed that he was the person who was responsible in a major way for the collapse of Communism in Eastern Europe. As Pope he made 103 international journeys and he became a pilgrim for dialogue and peace. He brought an extraordinary energy to the Papacy.



Many of us will recall the Popes visit to Ireland and how it affected all our lives and the wonderful spirit that animated the country in late 1979. I am sure many of you will have been present in the Phoenix Park when one million people gathered for the opening Mass. It was a wonderful day.

My special memory was being present in St. Peter's Square for his election. Pope John Paul I lived as Pope for just 33 days, when he died suddenly on the 28th September 1978. The Conclave to elect a new Pope began two weeks later which happened to coincide with my visit to Rome. However our flight from Dublin was delayed and we thought we had missed this unique opportunity. However on Monday morning the pilot announced "No white smoke". We were delighted at the news. After checking in at our hotel we rushed to St. Peter's Square and shortly afterwards we saw the white smoke coming from the Sistine Chapel. Then we awaited the announcement of the name. - Cardinal Karol Wojtyla. Who on earth was he? A man near us had a picture of all the Cardinals from an Italian newspaper. He pointed to the name in the bottom right hand corner. He was from Krakow - a Polish Pope. What a surprise. This began the 31 year reign of a very charismatic Pope who is being beatified today.
