### Letter from Diarmuid Martin, Archbishop of Dublin

8 May 2011

My dear people and priests,

I wish to thank you for your continued generous giving to the Dublin Diocesan development fund Share. Your generosity is all the more striking as it takes place at a time of very serious financial uncertainty, falling incomes and rising unemployment. Your contribution to the Share fund for the year ended June 2010, amounted to €8.08m which was a 6.2% decrease on the previous year.

Share is a concrete expression of the communion of the people of the diocese in the mystery of God and the life of the Church. In 2012 Dublin will be hosting the International Eucharistic Congress, from the 10th - 17th June. The theme of the congress is 'Eucharist - Communion with Christ and one another'. The celebration of the Eucharist is the summit and source of the life of the Church. Your contributions to Share at Sunday Mass are a vibrant expression of our communion with Christ and with one another.

Share also supports the process of renewal to which Pope Benedict has called us. Renewal requires conversion, a deeper communion on the mystery of Christ and the sharing across parish boundaries of personnel, facilities and resources to work more effectively for mission and evangelisation.

The process of renewal, locally, calls for pastoral services and supports at diocesan level. These are made possible by your contributions to Share, alongside its continuing support for parishes which are not financially self supporting.

I thank you once again and ask for your prayers for my ministry and that of the priests of the diocese and all who share in that ministry
