Team Ministry.

For more than two years we have been working jointly in the pastoral area of Crumlin, Mourne Road and Clogher Road. The Team ministry was established by Archbishop Diarmuid Martin. The members of the team are John Flaherty, who is Moderator, Dave Brannigan, John Deasy, Peter Coffey, Michael Kelly and Melvyn Mullins, together with Grainne Prior our Parish Pastoral Worker.

In the first year plus, we spent our time trying to find our way with a new project. It was not helped by the departure of both priests in Mourne Road. This set us back and stability is important. Now that John Flaherty has become the Moderator almost a year ago progress has been made.

Last Monday we had a Team meeting and issues engaging us included the establishment of a Youth Forum, World Youth Day in Madrid next August, Communications in the Parishes and that is why this Leading Article is in this week's Newsletter. We also discussed arrangements for Christmas and the New Year and the Service that marks the Closure of the Old Year @ 4pm on New Years Eve. St. Agnes will host the occasion this year. An important issue that will come up for discussion at Parish and area level is a reduction in the number of Masses. We cannot maintain the number of Masses into the future, with a reduced number of priests. This is where your views as expressed in the June Survey will be important and we thank you for filling up the survey which will help us shape the future Mass schedule in St. Agnes and across our Pastoral area.
