### Saints for Our Time

In October Pope Benedict canonized two Saints who speak to us today as we celebrate the Feast of All Saints. One was Damien of Molokai—the leper priest. In the time of Damien lepers were the rejects of society just like in the time of Jesus. Damien gave his total life to care and provide for those men, women and children who were exiled to their lonely island. As you may recall he caught the disease himself so that he could preach at the end of his life " we lepers". The illness nowadays can be controlled, however in his time it was a death sentence and during his last illness he refused to desert his fellow lepers. Damien died in 1889 and has been called the Mother Teresa of his generation. He is an example to us of dedication and commitment.



The second saint I wish to highlight for you today is St Jeanne Jugan, a native of France and foundress of the little Sisters of the Poor. She died ten years before St Damien. Both were canonized on the same day, 11th October 2009. Jeanne always, even from her early years, had a love for the poor and elderly. When she was young a beggar called to the door, and she gave up her bed and slept on the floor. When she founded the Little Sisters, she was joined by others, so that the work grew. After some years, she took over the direction of the novices, so that by the time she died many did not know she was the founder. She was self effacing.



In Ireland, the good work continues in Sybil Hill in Killester and Roebuck in Clonskeagh within the Diocese of Dublin. If you ever have occasion to visit their residences you can feel the love and lavish care given to the residents of these homes. The people there seem very content and happy and the wonderful work of the St Jeanne Jugan continues to this day. Thanks be to god. Fr John
