With just eight weeks to go to the end of the year it is important that we begin to look ahead at the changes that need to take place in the parish concerning the number of Masses celebrated at weekends and on weekdays in our Church. We are all well aware that some people find change difficult and disconcerting. However, in the light of the reduction in the number of priests now in active ministry in the parish, we do not have choices. Most people who attend the 10.00am Mass on weekdays will be aware that sometimes there are two funerals in the day. Funeral liturgies must be given time and this in turn has implications for the availability of priests to celebrate other Masses and attend to their pastoral duties. It is indeed, only in rare and special circumstances, that a priest is permitted to celebrate more than one Mass in the day.
 The new arrangement, with fewer Masses at weekends, will hopefully, enhance the quality of liturgy and will enable us to pool our liturgical resources more effectively, bringing a greater richness to our worship. With more time between Masses on Sunday morning, people will be able to enter and exit the Church at their ease.
