The Heart of St. Lawrence O' Toole

This week we celebrate the Feast of the Patron Saint of our Diocese-St. Lawrence O'Toole. Do you know where his heart is today? There are no prizes for knowing the answer. However if you want to know read to the end of this article on his life.

Lawrence O'Toole was born in Castledermot in Co. Kildare in 1128 of royal blood. He became Abbot of the Abbey at Glendalough founded by St. Kevin. He brought together the best of Celtic Monastic life, which was extremely strict, with the more modern European Monasticism. In 1162 he became Archbishop of Dublin. He was responsible for the development of the Cathedral of the most Holy Trinity-known to us today as Christ Church Cathedral.

Lawrence O'Toole was an energetic and saintly Archbishop. He showed special care for the poor of the City of Dublin, and set up centres where abandoned and orphaned children were looked after.

The year 1170 is a special date in Irish history as it was the beginning of the Norman Invasion, known well to you all from your study of Irish history. Henry II was the King of England and at that time the king could be found more often in France in pursuit of his expansion plans. To these Lawrence O'Toole travelled as a peacemaker in search of Henry II. Travel in those days was difficult and Henry II was not very welcoming. On his way home, Lawrence died in Eu, a small town in Normandy, worn out by his efforts to bring peace. He died on the 14th of November 1180. He was Canonised in 1225, and his heart today lies in a casket in Christ Church Cathedral, while his body remains in Eu. Now you know the answer to the question asked at the top of the page.
