FAREWELL TO THE OLD YEAR

You might well say, "The Parish Priest is loosing it" - you might be right but not on this item!!

This Sunday, the Feast of Christ the King is the last Sunday in the Church's year. Next weekend begins the Season of Advent. The King we praise today is not a ruler but a servant of his people. We thank Him for all that Jesus has done for us over the past 12 months. I hope you feel it has been a good year for you.

In the media at the end of December, it is usual for journalists to look back on the year that is closing, while expressing hopes for the future.
