Together in Faith.

October, Mission Month is upon us once again. The theme for the month 'Together in Faith' encourages all Christians to reflect on the meaning of God in their lives and in the society around them. An essential element of this understanding of Mission is community. The mission of a Christian community can often be centred on two aspects, how we follow the life of Jesus as community and as individuals and following the commands of Jesus to 'Go to all nations and baptise'.

All baptised Christians, whether born in the east or west, born rich or poor, born in the 'developed world' or the 'developing world' are called to mission. We are called to evangelise and bear witness to the gospel wherever we are from and to all people we encounter.

We are called by Christ to become His apostles in their own personal situation and in the world: 'As the father has sent me, so I send you' Jn. 20: 21.

In today's world, mission is not just located in some distant land but can be found in every location throughout the world and in everyday situations as many people have no sense of Christ or have lost their sense of God.

If knowing Jesus is worthwhile for us, then knowing Him is worthwhile for others. We should commit ourselves personally to making Him known. Each of us can do something that will make a difference. We could pray for a missionary spirit in our own hearts and in the heart of the Church. We could pray for some missionary we know. We could go out on mission for a few years-as many young people do-as lay missionaries. We could make contact with a missionary group and ask if there is anything we can do to help. We could 'go on the missions' for life as a priest or religious because without total commitment by some, temporary commitment by other won't be that effective. The important thing is that we do something we haven't done before. Let none of us say no to Our Lord. Let's take our instructions from Him, our example from the apostle's, our 'beat' from the Holy Spirit and let's get up and go.
