SISTER MARY – COLUMBAN SISTER

After many years ministering in our Parish, Sister Mary is leaving to reside in the Columban Motherhouse, Magheramore, Co. Wicklow. Sr. Mary spent 35 years working as a nurse in Hong Kong where she was well respected and admired for her dedication along with her Columban Sisters. While in Hong Kong she established Legion of Mary Cursillos and was also responsible for the building of a Hospice which is still carrying out its great work of caring for the terminally ill. When she returned to Ireland she spent one year in Magheramore, after which she came to the Columban Community here in Crumlin. For the past 14 years she has been a regular presence in our Parish and Church. She was very involved with the Parish Legion of Mary visiting the sick, the housebound and families who were in need. Sr. Mary also established the first ever Catholic Chaplaincy for the Chinese Community in Dublin and supported them with great pastoral care. Last Sunday she attended the Mass for the Chinese Community in St. Andrew's Church, Westland Row. Her work with them was valued and appreciated. Sr. Mary has reached her 88th year and feels it's time to return to the Motherhouse and catch up with her missionary colleagues who worked with her in Hong Kong and to enjoy some more time for quiet, peaceful prayer and relaxation in her life in the beautiful setting of the Motherhouse in Magheramore. On behalf of all of us in Crumlin Parish – thank you Sr. Mary for your kind, gentle, prayerful presence and for the love and support you have given to so many people in our parish and among the Chinese Community.

May God give you good health and strength each day and may you enjoy this time of restfulness with your Columban Sisters, a missionary Order who has made an incredible impact in the lives of thousands of people.

ST PIO RELIC

The 1st class relic of St Pio of Pietrelcina which the Padre Pio prayer group have for the general blessing after the monthly Mass will now be on permanent display within the Church. (The relic is a piece of congealed skin/blood from the wound of St. Pio)
