

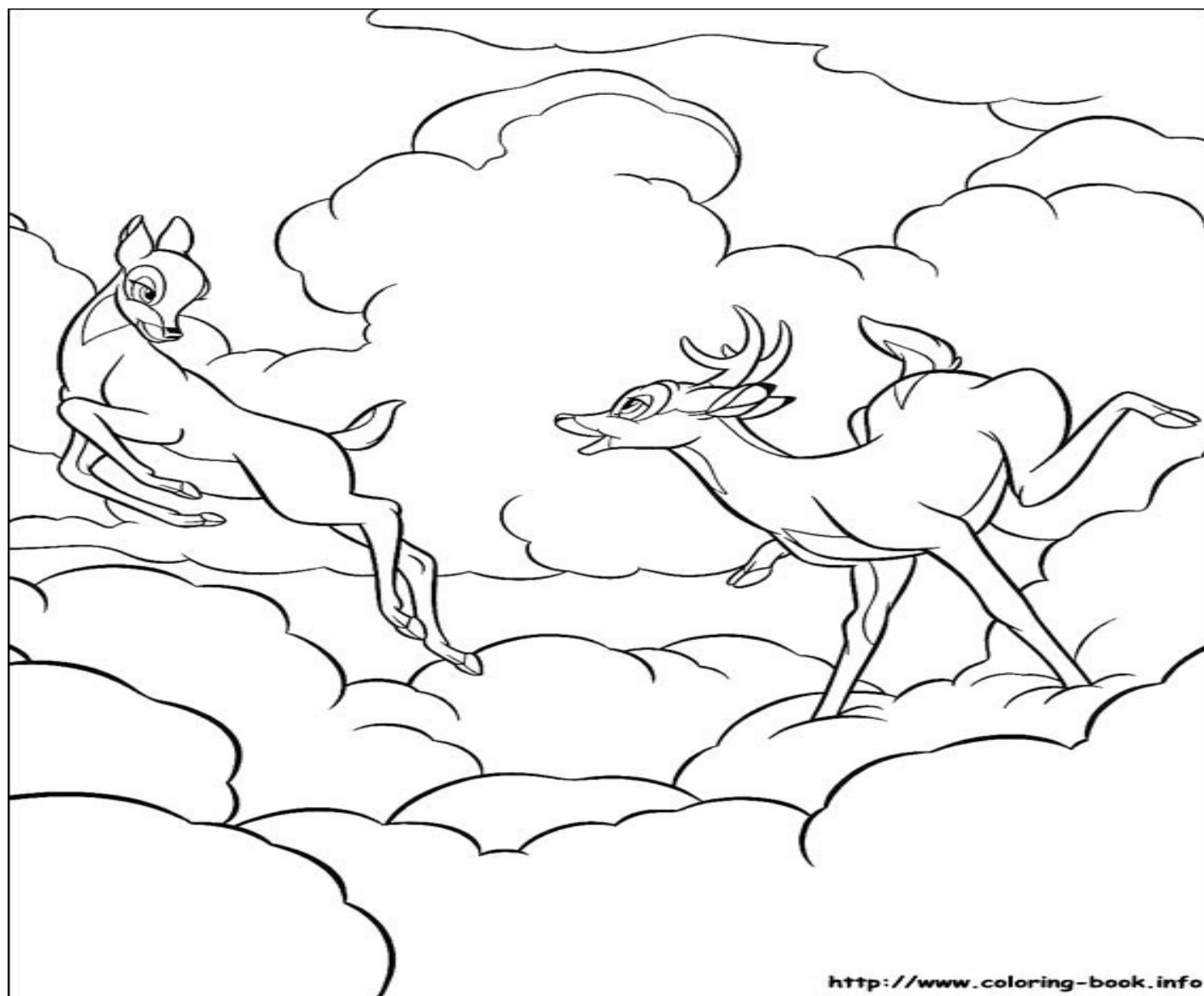
Applications for Permanent Diaconate: Permanent Diaconate is a voluntary ordained ministry, normally exercised in a part-time capacity. Deacons are engaged in a three-fold ministry of Word, Altar and Charity. The diocese of Dublin currently has eleven permanent deacons and eleven candidates in formation. The formation programme includes a preliminary year, three further years before ordination and two years after ordination. Applications are invited from men of faith between the ages of 35 and 60 who already have some track record of service in their parish or local community. 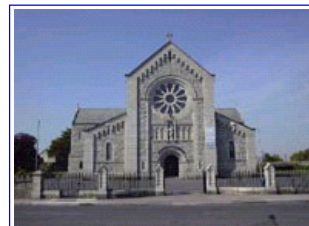

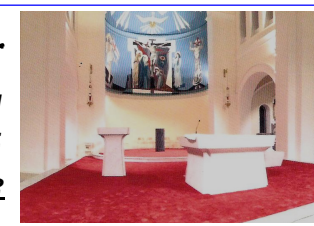

Dear Parishioners and Friends of St. Agnes'

It is that time of the year again for our Family Offering envelopes to be distributed to households in the parish. The boxes of envelopes are now available in the Parish Centre and can be collected after all masses this weekend as well as during office hours throughout the week. Should people prefer to contribute to this collection on a monthly basis, by 'Standing Order' with the bank, there are forms available in the Parish Centre for this purpose.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank all who faithfully contribute on a regular basis to this offering. The Family Weekly Offerings are our main source of income that covers the cost of insurance, heating, lighting and maintenance. You will be well aware that the cost of these items is increasing all the time and therefore it is important that we take the necessary steps to ensure that we are able to meet our weekly, financial commitments. Having invested so much in the refurbishment of our beautiful Church, it is important now that we take care of its upkeep and maintenance.

I appeal to those of you who are currently contributing to this weekly Family Offering to continue to do so and I appeal also to those who are **not** making a contribution to this collection, to give serious consideration to doing so. If a further one hundred people gave even €2.00 a week the benefit to the parish would amount to €10,000 at the end of the year.

You will be aware that the two collections taken up each Sunday go directly to the Diocese to cover the cost of salaries for the clergy, to support sick and retired clergy and to help poor parishes. The weekly Family Offerings is the only collection that goes directly to the parish, so you will appreciate how important it is to the parish finances.

May God bless you and reward you for your ongoing generosity.

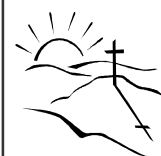
