**Year of Vocations**

Today starts a very important and vital year for the Church. A year devoted to Vocations. There are many vocations in life. We think of marriage, religious life, vocation to a cause, vocation to calling in life, but in this year the focus of direction is towards vocations to the priesthood and religious life. There can be few of us who are not aware of the difficulties being encountered in Parishes throughout the diocese [and indeed the whole country], by the shortage of priests. Vocations are at an all time low. With this in mind, a Year of Vocations has been instituted, to bring to our awareness our need for priests and religious men and women, and what we could do to promote vocations, and support our clergy.

We live in a very different world today. A world of wonder, and a world of fear. A world where a man can walk on the moon, but a man or woman fears to walk the streets of our cities and towns. We have everything to cater for our lives, but deep in the hearts core there can be loneliness, emptiness and hunger for something deeper, something more than passing pleasure.

Jesus understood our yearning for hope. He came to bring hope and the promise of eternal life. He gave us the Eucharist and the Sacraments. He left us the Mass, where we meet with Him daily, if we wish. He left us the good news. And He left us apostles who were appointed to spread the good news. These men and their successors have been shepherds to God's people for over 2000 years. But, with the bewildering changes in the world of the past years there has been a tendency to ignore vocations to the priesthood in favour of other career options.

God calls men and women 'Come follow Me'. So it is to God Himself that we must pray with loving and trustful urgency, now more than ever. Here in St. Agnes we have a branch of the St. Joseph's Young Priests Society. Every month on the second Tuesday after evening Mass, we gather in the Parish Centre to pray for vocations, to support with our donations the work of the Society in fostering vocations and in promoting our little prayer for vocations.

Keep listening, keep praying, remember all the priests who work so hard to bring us Gods love through the sacraments and through the good news. They stuck it out, like the apostles of old. It is not an easy life. It is a vocation, a challenge, a vital link between man and God. Without them we are like sheep without a shepherd.
