**THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK**

**The Holy Land**

St Mark's Gospel that we are currently listening to at Mass on Sunday, is noted for its simple style. Its descriptions are vivid and vibrant. It is an urgent account of the public life of Jesus, and it is apparent that the details described are consistent with a firsthand experience of the Lord. The Gospel of Mark deals mainly with the Galilean ministry of Jesus and the events of the last week before his death in Jerusalem. During the coming weeks on our journey towards Easter we will accompany the Lord with St Mark throughout Galilee. We will listen and observe all that God accomplished in his Son through his teaching, healing and preaching. Then on Palm Sunday we will see the triumphant entry into Jerusalem and watch as the mystery of our faith unfold and come alive in the events on Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday.

For a Christian I truly believe that a journey to the Holy land to follow the life of our Saviour and walk in his footsteps is indeed a great privilege. We would like to explore the possibility of a Pilgrimage to the Holy Land either in October this year or around February or March in 2013. Visits to the sites of the miracles of Jesus, the Mount of the beatitudes, the site of the Transfiguration, the town of Nazareth and sail on the sea of Galilee can help bring alive the scriptures we listen to week in and week out. Part of the experience would also include the Garden of Gethsemane the Upper room of the last supper, the way of the cross, the site of Calvary, the place of the Crucifixion and also experience the city of Jerusalem which is the meeting point of Judaism, Christianity and Islam. Part of the Journey would also take us to the town of Bethlehem and the Shepard's field and other numerous sites. It is a fascinating journey.

The duration would be 9 days. The total inclusive cost would be approximately €1500pp on a half board basis in 4 star hotels including all flights, transportation and the services of an experienced guide. If you are interested in partaking in such a pilgrimage could you please contact Mary in the parish office and leave your contact details and if we have enough people (20+) we will organise a meeting to set up the pilgrimage.

In the meantime as we begin the period of lent let us take time to Renew our Hearts, believe the Good News that Christ teaches. Reform our ways and Always remember that God loves us.
