Making a Difference

In his message for Lent this year Pope Benedict asks us to reflect on the importance of charitable giving. He reminds us of Jesus' challenge to all of us. "How does God's love abide in anyone who has the world's goods and sees a brother or sister in need and yet refuses to help?" [1Jn 3,17]

This is a challenge for all of us. But Pope Benedict reminds us that our responsibility is to be both charitable and just: "In those countries whose population is majority Christian, the call to share is even more urgent, since their responsibility towards the many who suffer poverty and abandonment is even greater. To come to their aid is a duty of justice even prior to being an act of charity" The problem can be that in this complicated world it can be hard to see what we as individuals can do to make the world a fairer place. One way in which we can do this is through thinking about what we buy. Many of the things we buy on an everyday basis can be traced back to the labour of men, women and even children in a developing country. If we could make choices that helped to ensure that these people could get a fair reward for their work, and that they could work under decent conditions we could go some way towards acting justly. "Before you finish eating your breakfast this morning you've depended on half the world. This is the way our universe is structured...we aren't going to have peace on earth until we recognise this basic fact." [Martin Luther King].

To help us to do that a group called Fairtrade Ireland provides information about fair trade products, what they are and where you can buy them. They have also organised Fairtrade fortnight [25th – Mar 9th] to highlight the issues involved. More information can be found at www.fairtrade.ie.
