Listen to Him

'This is my Son, the Beloved. Listen to him' These were the words of the
heavenly Father, heard through the cloud of divine presence on the
mountain. As a project for Lent it would be hard to think of a better
resolution than to give time every day to the prayer of listening to God.
Lent is about repenting and believing. We express our repenting in what we
give up for Lent. We can show our believing in what we take on. Many of us
are better at giving up than taking on. If we give time to prayer we will hear
the still quite voice of God within us calling us anew, to start again, to renew
our commitment to our baptism, to renew our commitment to Christ and His
Church.

So how can we renew our commitment to Jesus? Well, here in the parish
during Lent we offer Gospel Reflection groups and a retreat. Can you give
up 45 minutes each week during Lent to reflect on the Word of God? Gospel
Reflection takes place on Monday morning after the 10.00am Mass in the
Parish Centre and on Tuesday evenings at 7:45pm in the Parish Centre, or
maybe you would like to go to the parish retreat which is on every
Wednesday at 7.30pm in the Parish Centre during Lent? Have you some
spare time to volunteer in your parish, both the church and the parish teams
welcome new members. Would you like to sing in the choir, join the Family
Mass Group, there are many ways to play your part as a follower of Christ
here in St. Agnes. In our Gospel today we read about the transfiguration.
Lent is a time for all of us to be transfigured, to change, to grow as followers
of Christ. The Church here in Ireland needs to be transfigured but that can
only happen if ALL OF US plays our part in the building up of our parish
community, our diocese, our Church! So listen to what God is saying to you
this Lenten season, are you ready to listen, are you ready for your
transfiguration?

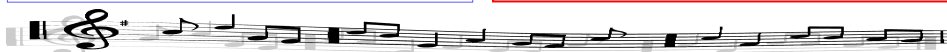
