A Mother's Grief.

On Friday night the 13th March there was cause for celebration in Tallaght. After many years without a home since they left Glenmalure Park in Milltown. Shamrock Rovers have found a new base where they were celebrating their first home match. Crowds gathered to mark the occasion.

At the same time down the road in Tymon North a tragedy was unfolding when a young man was gunned down and murdered. On Monday afternoon the Funeral Director rang to alert me that the funeral of the victim, Shay O'Byrne, would be coming to St Agnes Church. I had just been reflecting on what I would write in the Newsletter for Mother's Day this weekend.

This news caused me to reflect on how this death had turned a mother's concern for her son into a nightmare. Once again violence has cast a shadow and left a family in grief and pain. Will it ever end?. Guns seem to be obtained so easily and revenge with tit for tat killings seem to continue endlessly. Shay O'Byrne was baptised in St. Agnes Church many years ago he came in his mother's arm. A cause of joy and like any new born child a sign of hope. This hope has now been extinguished forever. Those who knew and loved him are left heartbroken. A mother will lay her son to rest just after Mother's Day when other families will be gathering to show their love for their mother. There will be no joy or celebration in the O' Byrne family- only pain and sorrow.

May I appeal for an end to the cycle of violence. All human life is sacred and only God has the right to take it away.
