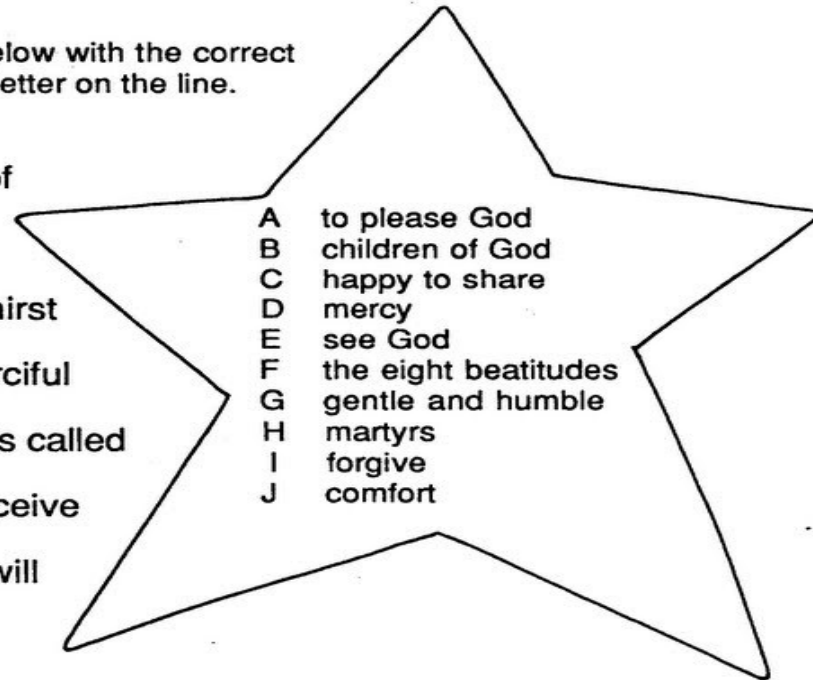

2nd November: Norms for Indulgences at the Commemoration of All Souls.

- 1) From 12 O'clock noon on November 1st until midnight on November 2nd, all who have confessed, received Holy Communion, and prayed for the Pope's intentions [One Our Father, and Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice] can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a Church or Oratory, and there reciting one Our Father and the Apostle's Creed. This indulgence is applicable only to souls of the departed. Confession may be made at any time within the week preceding or the week following November 1st.
- 2) The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable to the Holy Souls on the usual conditions once per day from November 1st to 8th. The conditions mentioned above apply also to this.

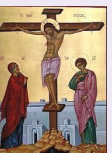


PARISH REPOSITORY
